Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them. <sup>16</sup> For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world.<sup>17</sup> The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever. 1 John 2:15-17

### 1. God's Love must only be used for \_\_\_\_\_

\*To truly understand what John is talking about we must first make sure we understand: LOVE \*John continually uses the word, LOVE to describe "Light's" behavior

\*"LOVE" is AGAPE = God's Love, given to us to be used in "appropriate" ways

\*Appropriate uses for Agape:

Agape directed to God =

Agape directed to One Another = \_\_\_\_\_

Agape directed to the Lost =

However, if we take God's love and use it "inappropriately" we disconnect ourselves from God! "... If anyone loves the world, *love for the Father is not in them.*" 1 John 2:15b

### 2. Loving the World is to engage in

"For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—*comes not from* the Father but from the world." 1 John 2:16

## 3. Christ-followers will be focused upon \_\_\_\_ !

"The world and its desires pass away, but *whoever does the will of God lives forever*." 1 John 2:17 \*All that which seeks to replace God in my life will pass away...it won't matter, it doesn't matter

\*Instead, Christ-followers will seek Kingdom Righteousness because it is eternal!

\*Kingdom Righteous = Think !

\*God isn't telling us that the stuff in the world is inherently bad...only that we can make it bad

\*The common problem is that we try to live a life of God + something
