As we let all of this soak in, we face one other question: How are we to do this Kingdom Work?

3 Very Dangerous Attitudes exist within the Christian Community concerning Kingdom Work:

- Many who consider themselves Christians either struggle to accept their role as Royal Priest & Ambassador or completely reject it all together, opting to live a "life of Christianity" of their own design, not God's design.
- 2. Many Christ-Followers eagerly embrace the role of Royal Priest & Ambassador but employ methods to advance the Kingdom that are in opposition to the methods used by Jesus & the Holy Spirit.
- 3. Oftentimes the above described Christ-Followers think 1 & 2 are talking to somebody else, not them!

Kingdom Fruit Must Bear the	to be Legitimate

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. ²He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. ³You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. ⁴Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

⁵ "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. ⁶ If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. ⁷ If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. ⁸ This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.
