## Bible Study Series: "Not So With You" (lesson 8) Jesus & the World (pt. 1) Tony Thornton, Minister August 5, 2020

As we explore some of the distinctive characteristics of Christ-Followers, consider a question: Why?

Why does God want us to be different? Is it simply so we will stand out and be noticed by others? It's becoming clear, that effort, rethinking & courage will be required to live as Christ-Followers!

But Why? To what end? To prove that it can be done? Or is there something else God has in mind?

To clarify this mystery, we will be looking at a word often used as a title of Jesus: Lord. Many Christ-Followers see LORD as one of two primary roles of \_\_\_\_ "For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior. 24 Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything." Ephesians 5:23-24 "And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world. 15 If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in them and they in God." 1 John 4:14-15 To understand what LORD means we must first reflect upon \_\_\_ Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20 "Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah." Acts 2:36 "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace 8 that he lavished on us. With all wisdom and understanding, 9 he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ, <sup>10</sup> to be put into effect when the times reach their fulfillment—to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ." Ephesians 1:7-10 If Jesus has defeated Evil, and has all Authority, why is everything still so ? Why do the nations conspire and the peoples plot in vain? <sup>2</sup>The kings of the earth rise up and the rulers band together against the LORD and against his anointed, saying, <sup>3</sup> "Let us break their chains and throw off their shackles." <sup>4</sup>The One enthroned in heaven laughs; the Lord scoffs at them. <sup>5</sup> He rebukes them in his anger and terrifies them in his wrath, saying, <sup>6</sup> "I have installed my king on Zion, my holy mountain."

- <sup>7</sup>I will proclaim the LORD's decree: He said to me, "You are my son; today I have become your father.

  <sup>8</sup> Ask me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession.
- <sup>9</sup> You will break them with a rod of iron; you will dash them to pieces like pottery."
- <sup>10</sup> Therefore, you kings, be wise; be warned, you rulers of the earth.
- <sup>11</sup> Serve the LORD with fear and celebrate his rule with trembling.
- <sup>12</sup> Kiss his son, or he will be angry and your way will lead to your destruction,

for his wrath can flare up in a moment. Blessed are all who take refuge in him. Psalm 2
