Followers of Christ have become citizens of the Kingdom of God: Ambassadors & Priests of the King! We try to embrace what God has done for us, what God wants in this world, and our role in it.

Jesus commissioned His disciples to make disciples:

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore **go and make disciples of all nations**, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and **teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you**. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20

Today, we will look at the central curriculum Jesus used to teach His disciples: The Sermon of the Mount "Now when Jesus saw the crowds, he went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to him, ² and he began to teach them." Matthew 5:1,2

Jesus begins by revealing the Kingdom definition of "Blessed"

He said: ³"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. ⁴ Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted. ⁵ Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. ⁶ Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled. ⁷ Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. ⁸ Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. ⁹ Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God. ¹⁰ Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. ¹¹ "Blessed"
