"The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and **recovery of sight for the blind**, to set the oppressed free, ¹⁹ to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Luke 4:18-19

Nicodemus was a deeply religious, principled man but lacked the basic ingredient to even **SEE** the Kingdom: Spiritual Blindness

"Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again." John 3:3

Our world is suffering greatly from Spiritual Blindness, the cause: Sin, Rebellion/Ignoring God, choosing knowledge over God

This is the point of Jesus' parable:

And he told them this parable: "The ground of a certain rich man yielded an abundant harvest. 17 He thought to himself, 'What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.'

¹⁸ "Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store my surplus grain. ¹⁹ And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of grain laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry."'

²⁰ "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?'

²¹ "This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is **not rich toward God.**" Luke 12:16-21
