**Did you ever attempt to learn a new language?**

**Did you ever become “fluent”?**

**The Indwelling of God’s Spirit brings us to fluency in the new language of behavior in 3 Ways:**

#### 1. By Providing us with Christian \_\_\_\_\_

“Now we **ask you, brothers and sisters**, to acknowledge those who work hard among you, who care for you in the Lord and who admonish you. <sup>13</sup>Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work. Live in peace with each other.” 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13

#### 2. By Providing us with the Blessing of \_\_\_\_\_

“And we **urge you, brothers and sisters**, warn those who are idle and disruptive, encourage the disheartened, help the weak, be patient with everyone. <sup>15</sup>Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always strive to do what is good for each other and for everyone else.”

1 Thessalonians 5:14-15

#### 3. By Providing us with specific behaviors to learn in our \_\_\_\_\_ & then in our \_\_\_\_\_:

“Rejoice **always**,

<sup>17</sup>pray **continually**,

<sup>18</sup>give thanks in **all circumstances**; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.

<sup>19</sup>Do not quench the Spirit. <sup>20</sup>Do not treat prophecies with contempt <sup>21</sup>but test them all; hold on to what is good, <sup>22</sup>reject every kind of evil.” 1 Thessalonians 5:16-22

#### Conclusion:

“May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. **May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.** <sup>24</sup>The one who calls you is faithful, and he will do it.
