What is a Talent/Talanton?

A Talanton is a measurement or weight equaling 6000 denarii
A denarius was considered to be a "days wage"
6000 denarii = approximately 25 years of wages.
6000 days wage of \$15/hour = approximately one million dollars!

- 2. Sharing fellowship with the Master & being entrusted with more refers to eternity!
